It should also be clear that the benefits and risks of these technologies could be unevenly distributed among different races, gender groups, and social class. It is essential for us to consider *how to design, use, and regulate* digital technologies. This public lecture series invites internationally renowned scholars to discuss major normative questions related to the design, use, and regulation of information technology for a good society.
